That is, the student is used to staying out late at night and practically getting his or her own way at home, whereas, when the student attends a residential school, such as this, he or she finds his or her freedom reduced. To escape these rules, the student quits or drops out. Octually, the latter reason is quite unexcuseable, as the student merely lacks the courage to continue and adhere to rules and face responsibility.
